## CARE OF FINISHES

Regular dusting and wiping with warm soapy water should be sufficient to keep finishes in their original condition for long periods. Extra cleaning for certain finishes should be carried out as shown below.

### POLISHED AND LACQUERED FINISHES

Use a good quality wax polish occasionally and on externally fitted items this should be carried out every month.

It should be noted that the life of lacquer on most items is limited and will eventually break down. Adverse conditions such as industrial pollution, sea air, acid rain, abrasion etc and repeated continual handling may cause the coating to deteriorate prematurely.

### PLATED FINISHES

Occasional wiping with a soft cloth and cleaning with a non abrasive wax polish.

### STAINLESS STEEL

Whilst stainless steel is a strong durable material, it will , with the exception of grade 316 marine quality stainless steel, show signs of rust if not maintained regularly. (Especially in coastal areas or areas with aggressive atmospheres such as swimming pools.)

We therefore recommend the following cleaning procedures.

Clean regularly with a dry cloth or duster.

Periodic washing with warm soapy water dried with a clean cloth.

Wipe occasionally with a good quality silicone wax polish.

### ALL FINISHES

**Please do not use any abrasive or acid based cleaning products at any time.**
